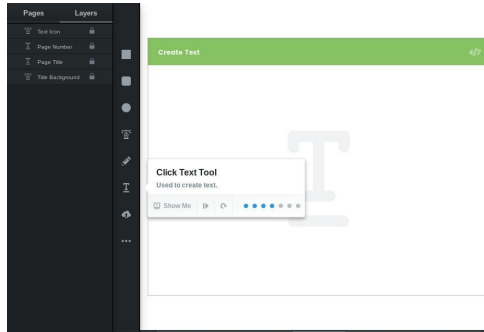
Getting started ..

When I first logged in, it took me on a guided tour. Each 'next' linked to videos

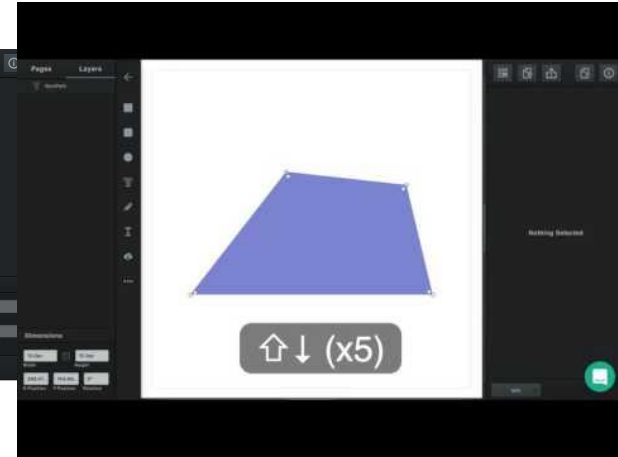
Pen tool and drawing paths

I noticed sometimes I had to Right Click to find what I wanted in lieu of a tool.

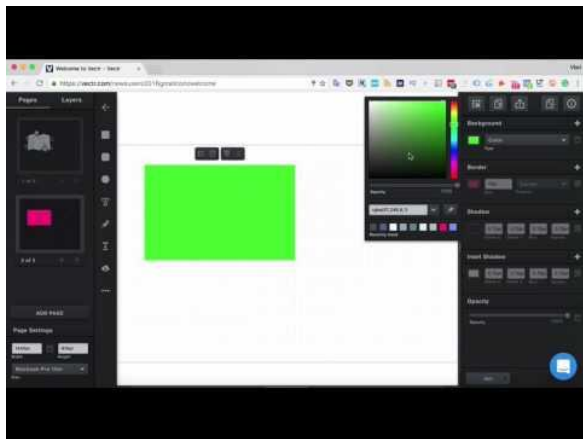

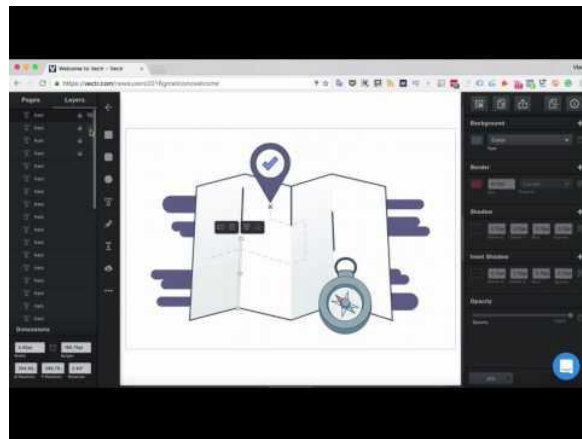

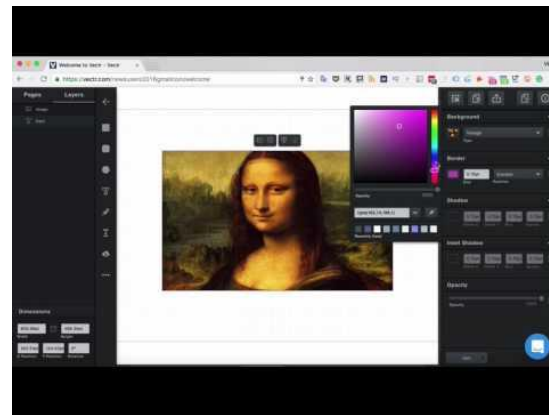
